



# 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual MCAASEES Workshop:

Regional Security Threats, Challenges and Opportunities

8 – 10 April 2014, Skopje, Macedonia

Sponsored by Alumni Programs, College of International and Security Studies George C. Marshall European Center for Security Studies

BACKGROUND/PURPOSE: The goal of Marshall Center Alumni Associations is to effect positive change in their countries that promote stability and security and to bring greater attention to resolving defense, foreign policy or regional security issues. Alumni associations endorsed by the Marshall Center are independent, not-for-profit entities and the purpose and structure of individual associations are determined exclusively by the membership. In June 2011, at a Regional Alumni Leaders Workshop conducted at the Marshall Center, senior Alumni leaders from 14 nations in the greater Southeast Europe region (including Moldova and Ukraine) decided on their own initiative to create the first-ever regional Marshall Center alumni association. At the workshop, a mission statement and charter was developed and formally approved, a leadership election held, and an official charter signing ceremony conducted. The official name of the association was designated as the Marshall Center Alumni Association for Southeast European Security (MCAASEES). The 1st official meeting of the MCAASEES occurred from 14-16 May 2012 in Podgorica, Montenegro and was co-sponsored by the Montenegrin Ministry of Defense. The topic of the workshop was "Regional Cooperation in the Security Sector" and was attended by 13 of the 14 member nations.

This 2nd Annual MCAASEES workshop seeks to examine the current security environment in the region, review current regional security threats, challenges and opportunities, and conduct a formal business meeting of the Association.

### **OBJECTIVES:**

Overall objectives for this MCAASEES Workshop are:

- Increase awareness and understanding of regional security issues and how best the MCAASEES can impact the region.
- Improve regional cooperation in Southeast Europe and neighboring states by using a Regional Alumni Association as a tool to share and discuss security issues common throughout the region.
- Identify current regional security threats, challenges and opportunities, and develop regional and national recommendations to effectively counter these threats.
- Conduct a formal business meeting of the Association and discuss past results, lessons learned and planned upcoming activities.
