



5th Annual MCAASEES Workshop:

Development of Southeast Europe Regional Security Structures

26 - 28 September 2017, Ljubljana, Slovenia

BACKGROUND/PURPOSE: The goal of Marshall Center alumni associations is to effect positive change in their countries in order to promote stability and security and to bring greater attention to resolving defense, foreign policy or regional security issues. Alumni associations endorsed by the Marshall Center are independent, not-for-profit entities and the purpose and structure of individual associations are determined exclusively by the membership. In June 2011, at a Regional Alumni Leaders Workshop conducted at the Marshall Center, senior alumni leaders from 14 nations in the greater Southeast Europe region (including Moldova and Ukraine) decided on their own initiative to create the first-ever regional Marshall Center alumni association. At the workshop, a mission statement and charter was developed and formally approved, a leadership election held, and an official charter signing ceremony conducted. The official name of the association was designated as the Marshall Center Alumni Association for Southeast European Security (MCAASEES). Four meetings of the MCAASEES have occurred to date in Podgorica, Montenegro (14-16 May 2012), Skopje, Macedonia (8-10 April 2014), Bucharest, Romania (23-25 September 2015), and Tirana, Albania (19-21 September 2016).

This 5th Annual MCAASEES workshop seeks to examine and discuss key regional threats and countermeasures in Southeast Europe (SEE) and conduct a formal business meeting of the Association.

OBJECTIVES:

Overall objectives for this MCAASEES Workshop are:

- Increase awareness and understanding of regional security issues and how best the MCAASEES can impact the region.
- Improve regional cooperation in Southeast Europe and neighboring states by using a regional alumni association as a tool to share and discuss security issues common throughout the region.
- Examine current and emerging security and defense threats to Southeast Europe and develop regional and national recommendations to effectively counter these threats in order for the Balkans to achieve long term security and stability.
- Conduct a formal business meeting of the Association and discuss past results, lessons learned and planned upcoming activities.
